## **Senator Michael L. MacDonald to present Senate 150 Medal to North Lochaber resident Robert Inglis**

**Ottawa, January 9, 2018** – Senator Michael L. MacDonald is honoured to nominate Robert Inglis of North Lochaber, Nova Scotia, to receive the Senate of Canada 150 Medal.

Mr. Inglis has been a devoted community volunteer in Nova Scotia for decades. As a resident of Sydney, he volunteered with the United Way of Cape Breton County; the Resi-Care Cape Breton Association for developmentally challenged adults; the Cape Breton Family YMCA; the Riverview Y's Men's Club; the Boy Scouts of Canada; as well as the First United Church. While in Halifax, Mr. Inglis served as a Colonel of Citadel Hill and was regularly involved in fundraising activities for community service organizations.

“Bob Inglis has been a pillar of our community for decades,” says Senator MacDonald. “He always seemed to be involved in one capacity or another, dedicating his time and energy to the community and organizations where he has lived.”

The Senate of Canada 150 Medal celebrates the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the first sitting of the Senate, and was created to recognize the outstanding contributions of Canadians from all walks of life, through generosity, dedication, volunteerism and hard work.

Senator MacDonald will present the medal to Mr. Inglis at a ceremony at the Lochaber Centre (1555 Highway 7, Lochaber, NS) on Saturday, January 20, at 2pm, with a reception to follow. Members of the public are welcome.
